

PROPER UNIFORMS AND APPEARANCE

Individual units are permitted to wear matching uniforms of whatever style or color of outer garments their unit approves.

Foothill-Citrus umpires are required to wear black outer shirts with white piping down the side, or powder blue outer shirts with black piping down the side.

Umpires are also **required** to wear predominately black shoes during the regular season and any level of the CIF-SS playoffs. (Allowing for a manufacturer's logo to be white)

The CBUA patch (gold fringe for black outer garments or powder blue shirts with black collars) **is required**. The patch is to be worn on the left pocket and in approximately the same location for pullovers without pockets. Umpires are to wear charcoal grey umpire pants. All officials are required to be in the same uniform. The plate umpire may wear a short-sleeved shirt while base umpires may wear appropriate pullover. American flags are optional. If worn, the flag shall be 2" by 3¼" in size and worn on the upper back, middle of the outer garment.

****NOTE** Umpire crews working CIF-SS semi-finals and final games are required to wear black outer garments, hats, belts, and ball bags. If worn, the piping color and style on pullover jackets must match for the entire crew.**

Due to weather, this requirement may be waived by the CBUA Board when appropriate.

PLATE AND BASE UNIFORM

Black pullover shirt (white piping down the side)
Powder blue pullover shirt (black piping down the side)
Charcoal grey umpire pants
Fitted black cap (Cap not necessary with hockey mask)
Black belt (patent leather OK)
Black socks
Black (or white) undershirts

****NOTE** Umpire crew must have matching under shirts**

Plate umpire must wear black bags
CBUA patch to be worn on outermost garment
Piping color must match on pullover jackets.
