- 1. In the first inning
- 2. With two outs in any inning
- 3. After a close call on a play
- 4. After an argument or conflict
- 5. After a pitching change
- 6. After a big inning
- 7. When a game becomes a blowout
- 8. After a GREAT or after a BAD call by either you or your partner
- 9. During threatening weather
- 10. Resuming a game after a rain delay
- 11. The last two innings of a game
- 12. When the game is moving very slowly
